Note...1: Halmic

After 1NT-Dbl-p forces Redbl then  $2\clubsuit=2\spadesuit+M$ ,  $2\heartsuit=\heartsuit+\spadesuit$   
-Redbl forces  $2\clubsuit$  to show 5-card suit  
- $2\clubsuit=2\spadesuit+\heartsuit$   
- $2\heartsuit=\heartsuit+\spadesuit$   
- $2\heartsuit=\heartsuit+\spadesuit$   
After 1NT-p-p-Dbl-Redbl shows 5-card suit.

Note...2: Smith Peters in defence of NT contracts

Defender on lead peters at first opportunity to show desire for a switch  
Partner peters at first opportunity to ask for first suit to be continued.

Note...3: Rosenkrantz Redbl

After 1x-1y-Dbl(neg)-Redbl shows A,K or Q in suit y.

Note...4: Lebensohl

After  $2\clubsuit$ -Dbl-p-2NT is puppet to  $3\clubsuit$  then  $3\heartsuit$  or  $3\spadesuit$  is to play,  $3\clubsuit$  shows  $4\heartsuit$  and  $\spadesuit$  stop, 3NT not  $4\heartsuit$  and  $\spadesuit$  stop  
After  $2\heartsuit$ -Dbl-p-2NT is puppet to  $3\clubsuit$  then  $3\heartsuit$  is to play,  $3\heartsuit$  shows  $4\clubsuit$  and  $\heartsuit$  stop,  $3\clubsuit$  shows  $5\clubsuit$  and  $\heartsuit$  stop, 3NT shows  $\spadesuit$  stop  
After 2M-Dbl-p- $3\clubsuit$  shows  $4+$   $\clubsuit$ , 8+ hcp  
After 2M-Dbl-p- $3\heartsuit$  shows  $4+$   $\heartsuit$ , 8+ hcp  
After  $2\clubsuit$ -Dbl-p- $3\heartsuit$  shows  $4\heartsuit$ , 8+ hcp, no  $\spadesuit$  stop

Note...7: After  $1\clubsuit$ -p-1NT-p- $3\clubsuit$ -p then  $3\heartsuit=3\spadesuit$  or  $5\heartsuit$

Similarly  $4\heartsuit$  shows  $\clubsuit$

Note...10: Kokish

After  $2\clubsuit$ -p- $2\heartsuit$ -p- $2\heartsuit$  puppet to  $2\clubsuit$  then  $2NT=25+$  bal  
then  $2NT=Jxxxxx$  in either m  
then  $3m=A,K$  or  $Qxxxxx$  in m

Note...11: Transfers after 1NT

After 1NT-p- $2\heartsuit$ -p then  $2\heartsuit=<4\heartsuit$   
 $2\clubsuit, 3\clubsuit$  and  $3\heartsuit$  show  $4\heartsuit$ , max & shortage  
 $2NT$  shows  $4\heartsuit$ , max & no shortage  
 $3\heartsuit$  shows  $4\heartsuit$ , min  
Similar after  $2\heartsuit$  tfr to  $2\clubsuit$   
After 1NT-p- $2\clubsuit$ -p then  $2NT$  denies Qxx or better in  $\clubsuit$ , subsequent bid by responder shows suit/fragment

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Note...9: 3♣ 5 card Stayman

Then 3♦=4M or 2♠

then after 3♦ 3♥ denies 4♥ (does not promise 4♠)

3♠ promises 4♥ and denies 4♠

3NT promises 4♥ and 4♠, game only

4♣ promises 4♥ and 4♠, slam try

4♥ promises 4♣, slam try

3♥=5♥ then 3♠ is slam try in ♥

3♠=5♠ then 4♣ is slam try in ♠

4♦ natural

4♥ shows ♣

3NT=3♠, not 4♥, then 4♥ is transfer to 4♠
